

Minor and machinery in nature	<p>The proposal is machinery in nature, notifying a change to the Legal Profession (Society) Rules 2007 (Society Rules) made by the Council of the Queensland Law Society (QLS) to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>make minor amendments to rule 16 to delete sub-rule 16(1) – the annual subscription payable for the 2024-2025 financial year, and renumber sub-rule 16(1) to sub-rule 16(1A);</li> <li>set the membership fees for the 2026-2027 financial year (amendment of rule 16 – annual subscription and schedule 2 – fees, subscriptions and levies);</li> <li>make minor amendments for internal consistency (amendment of rule 26 to delete 'General Manger, Regulation' and insert 'Chief Regulation Officer').</li> </ol> <p>The proposal does not result in a substantive change to regulatory policy or new impacts on business, government or the community.</p>
