

Regulatory proposals where no RIA is required	<p>The Legal Profession (Strengthening Disciplinary Matters) Amendment Bill 2026 gives effect to the recommendations of the <i>QCAT Act Statutory Review 2025-26: Legal practitioner jurisdiction Report (October 2025)</i> by amending the <i>Legal Profession Act 2007</i> to transfer the legal practitioner jurisdiction from the Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal to the Supreme Court of Queensland (Supreme Court) and clarify the procedural and costs arrangements in the Supreme Court.</p> <p>The proposal relates to the administration of courts and tribunals. No regulatory impact analysis is required under the Queensland Government Better Regulation Policy.</p>
