Regulatory proposals where no Regulatory Impact Analysis is required	The proposal to amend the Residential Services (Accreditation) Regulation 2018 to permanently exempt retirement villages from the requirements of the Residential Services (Accreditation) Act 2002 will not increase costs or regulatory burden. The proposal is deregulatory and aims to remove the requirements on business that would arise when the exemption expires to avoid increased costs on retirement villages (which would be passed onto residents).
